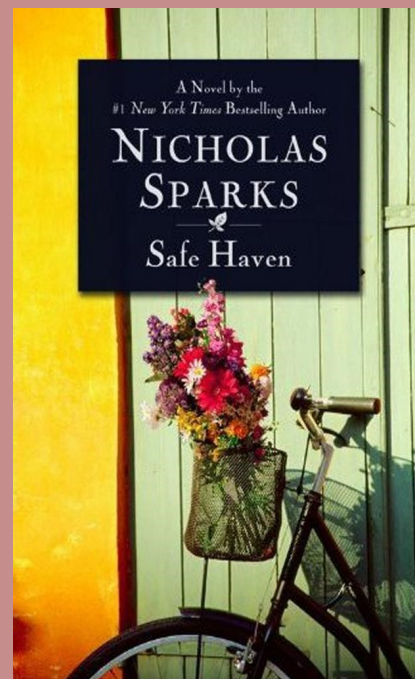
Bio: High school students meet in detention.
